Eligibility:

- Active undergraduate students (minimum 2nd year).
- TOEFL PBT 500 / IELTS 5.5 or equivalent.
- Minimum GPA of 3.00/4.00.

Required Documents:

- 1. Letter of Recommendation (English)
- 2. Proof of Enrollment (English)
- 3. English proficiency test score.
- 4. Latest academic transcript (English).
- 5. Valid passport copy (min. 2 years validity) or Student ID.
- 6. Health certificate.

First Semester

Application Date : October until Mid November

Study Period : February until June

Second Semester

Application Date : May until Mid June

Study Period : August until February
